

- 1. This scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors in the year they graduate from high school.
- 2. This scholarship is available to Maine Antique Tractor Club member's dependent that demonstrate a vested interest in our club and that have been a member for at least one year immediately prior to the date of application and remain a member during the year in which the scholarship is awarded. If the student turns 18 years of age prior to awarding of the scholarship, they must become a member of MATC in their own right.
- 3. Each graduating senior who would like a scholarship must fill out the application form and submit it no later than <u>April 30<sup>th</sup></u> of that year and return it to the address below.
- 4. A recent picture is requested to accompany the application and can be returned upon request to the applicant. All award recipients consent to having their information published in our newsletter and other media including Facebook unless a written request not to is received by us with the application.
- 5. MATC scholarship funds will be available to applicants who are accepted and attend any University, College, Community College, Junior College, or Trade School of higher learning with preference given to a student majoring in an agriculture or related field. The scholarship will be awarded directly to the applicant in the form of a check shortly before the beginning of the fall semester and should be used for tuition, books, supplies, or other necessities needed to begin school.
